Road Rules Refresher Tip 7

Traffic Information Page

South Australian Police

With Australia being one of the most motorised nations on earth, it's no wonder we need to have road rules in place to keep road users safe on roads!

RULES YOU CAN LIVE WITH!

On 1 December 1999, the South Australian State Government implemented a revised set of national road laws. Whilst some important road rules changed, it is important to remember that the basic road rules still apply.

That is:

you **must** obey the speed limit you **must** wear your seat belt you **must** not cross double lines you **must** obey traffic signs, lights and road markings.

Remember, if you are caught disobeying the road rules, you could face penalties including fines and demerit points.

THE MOST RECENT CHANGES TO THE ROAD RULES

The following are a selection of the revised road rules that now apply in South Australia. Make sure you and members of your family are familiar with the rules. You can view a full copy of the Road Rules - www.transport.sa.gov.au/legislation/existing/legislation/index.asp or Government Bookstore, 77 Grenfell St, Adelaide.

Keeping to the left on a multi-lane road

Drivers must not drive in the right lane on multi-lane roads with a speed limit over 80 km/h unless overtaking, turning right, making a

U-turn, avoiding an obstruction or if traffic is congested. Irrespective of the speed limit there may be signs which state that a driver must keep to the left.


Travel in or on a motor vehicle

Passengers must not travel unrestrained in the load area of a vehicle. This applies to the back of trucks and utilities that do not have a solid enclosed canopy. In the back of panel vans and station wagons (unless extra seats have been fitted) the practice is not recommended. Where there are seats with belts fitted, then these must be occupied before seats without belts.

Merging when two lanes become one

Where two lanes merge, and a broken white line separates them, drivers crossing the line will be changing lanes and must give way to vehicles on the right. If there is no line, the leading driver has right of way and the drivers of subsequent vehicles merge together like a zipper.

It is an offence for vehicle B in the diagram below to increase it's speed to prevent vehicle A from merging.

Giving way at roundabouts

All cars, pedestrians and push bike riders are required to give way to motorists entering or leaving a roundabout.

Wheeled toys, skate-boards and in-line skates on footpaths

People riding on skate-boards, in-line skates and wheeled toys are required to wear helmets and to give way to pedestrians.

Using pedestrians crossings

Pedestrians are required to use the pedestrian crossing facility if there is one within 20 metres of where they want to cross.

Stopping and parking

The time limit allowed when stopping in a no parking area for the purpose of dropping off or picking up passengers or goods is two minutes.

Motorists must not stop their vehicles in areas where there is a continuous yellow painted line on the edge of the road.

Stopping and parking on a curve in rural areas will be prohibited unless the vehicle is visible for 100 metres to vehicles approaching from behind, or if a parking control sign applies.

Stopping or parking is prohibited within 10 metres of the kerb line at intersections without traffic lights, unless signs provide otherwise.

Stopping or parking is prohibited within 20 metres of the kerb line at intersections which have traffic lights.

Vehicles entering special purpose lanes

(i.e. bus/tram lanes, etc.)

Ordinary vehicles can enter special purpose lanes (other than bicycle lanes) up to 100 metres prior to an intersection, for the purpose of turning.

Ordinary vehicles can enter bicycle lanes up to 50 metres prior to the intersection for the purpose of turning.

Riding your bike

Cyclists are prohibited from riding their bicycles on footpaths, unless the riders are under 12 years of age. Cyclists under 12 are required to wear helmets and give way to pedestrians and when practicable, keep to the left of the footpath.

The following people may also ride on the footpath, but must keep left and give way to pedestrians:

- Adults (18 years or older) who are accompanying and supervising children (under 12 years)
- Cyclists must dismount when crossing a pedestrian, school or marked foot crossing.

Use of hazard warning lights

Motorists whilst driving can now use their hazard warning lights if their vehicle is in fog or similar circumstances.

Giving way to pedestrians who are crossing a slip lane

Drivers need to be aware that they must always give way to pedestrians who are crossing a slip lane.
