*Except where this Monday falls on a long weekend then the meeting is held on the third Monday of the month.





Membership officer: - First point of contact for visitors that come to MLR, keeps track of criteria for membership acceptance.

Website officer: - Looks after MLR website and Facebook administration

Property Officer: - Looks after club property and trailer, by maintaining where appropriate and lends equipment out to members.

Education Officer: - Organises club training and awareness days. Liaises with 4WDSA Driver Training Unit for wider training opportunities.

Magazine editor: - Collates all material to go into club magazine – photos, trip reports, jokes, interesting 4WD related stories sourced elsewhere. Facebook administration.

Committee Member: - Supports other Officers of the committee, and helps with club events and trips where needed.



MLR RECIPE BOOK

Chocolate Brownie Cob Loaf - (great for a camp cook dessert!!!)

INGREDIENTS

3 Cups Self Raising Flour
3 tbsp Cocoa
2 tbsp Caster Sugar
1 tbsp Golden Syrup
100 grams Chocolate Melts
3 tbsp Butter
100 grams White Chocolate Melts
1 Cup Milk

You can make this Chocolate Brownie Cob Loaf the night before. It is easier to 'scoop out the middle' if it is cold.

Sift the self-raising flour, caster sugar and cocoa into a bowl. Add the butter and use your fingertips to 'rub together' the mix until the mixture comes together like breadcrumbs. Add the chocolate melts and golden syrup. Fold in the milk and knead lightly until it comes together. Line a large cake tin with baking paper. Place the Cob Loaf into the cake tin, heaping it up in the centre to give it the 'cob loaf' shape. Bake for 30 minutes or until the outside has formed a hard crust. Allow cooling in the pan.

Caramel Sauce :

1 tin "Top n Fill" caramel filling
1 tbs butter
½ cup cream
100 grams white choc buttons

Melt all ingredients together in a saucepan until combined and butter and choc. Melted.

Either scoop out centre of cake (without going through the bottom) and fill with caramel sauce. Wrap in a couple of layers of alfoil and reheat through. Or, just re-heat cake whole and serve caramel sauce on the side with icecream.



Please let your members know it is available and encourage them to try it.



