**Secretary & Public Officer:** - Minute taking for meetings. Correspondence in and out.

**Trips Coordinator:** - Primary point of contact for members trip planning, advice and attendance sheets. Communicates trip calendar to members.

**4WDSA Delegate:** - Attends bi-monthly 4WDSA meetings and is the voice of MLR, also reports back on any relevant information from 4WDSA that affects MLR.

**Membership officers** (1 lead & 2 x assistants): - First point of contact for visitors that come to MLR, keep track

of member attendance at club meetings and criteria for membership acceptance, welcome visitors and link them with a buddy, run the club night raffle and pay for any birthday drinks.

**Website officer:** - Maintain and update MLR website and Facebook administration.

**Merchandise officer:** - Organises clothing and other club approved merchandise for sale to members.

**Property Officer:** - Looks after club property and trailer, by maintaining where appropriate and lends equipment out to members.

**Education Officer:** - Organises club training and awareness days. Liaises with 4WDSA Driver Training Unit for wider training opportunities.

Magazine editor: - Collates all material to go into club magazine - photos, trip reports, jokes, interesting 4WD related stories sourced elsewhere. Facebook administration.

Committee Member: - Supports other Officers of the committee, and helps with club events and trips where needed. If you would like to share your experience and contribute to the running of the club, please speak to a current committee member to obtain a nomination form.



### Planning a Club Trip/Event


Anyone planning a club trip or event please follow the procedure as per below.


### **Trip Report**



## Ngarkat Interclub Working Bee Saturday 25th - Sunday 26th March

Four Wheel Drive SA in conjunction with the Senior Ranger, Natural Resources (SA Murray-Darling Basin & DEW) from Lameroo conduct a working bee annually with volunteers from FWDSA affiliated clubs undertaking a number of tasks. These tasks assist DEWNR in maintaining, sustaining and enhancing the Ngarkat Conservation Park for all visitors.

Arriving on the Friday late afternoon to set up camp Dave Cunningham, Rob Stevens and Paul Parsons represented Mount Lofty, being three of the 35 vehicle contingent. The tasks included work on or adjacent the Border Track focusing mainly on the one-way section with some work an the



southern two-way section past Shaugh Track. As Border track is closed for the summer months it was good to be putting the first tyre prints on some sections, until a second group "leap frogged" while we completed the job at hand. We were allotted the track maintenance tasks commencing about 4km past the one-way gate all the way through to about 2km past Shaugh track on the way to the Red Bluff turnoff, some 48km of sand driving. This consisted of filling the holes (dug by the application of too much accelerator driving 35 inch muddies perhaps?) and

repairing the geotech matting and mesh that had been torn up by low hanging tow balls. Much of the mesh was able to be re pegged but there was quite a bit of cutting away those section too badly damaged to retain. With tyres down to 15 to 18PSI the sand became progressively dryer and softer as the day marched on with one massive dune the outright winner. With two tracks up, both Robs Land Rover and Pauls 200 made about the same distance before the sand won, so it was back to the chicken track that at one stage looked as if that may have also have won but a bit more momentum with all the tools in the back jumping up and down as we traversed the reverse moguls the crest was reached enabling us to walk back and re fix the matting.

It was a longish day with some heavy sand shovelling that saw us reach the western end of the Shaugh track and re-air, with Robs compressor calling time after just two tyres getting up to 30PSI. Paul's compressor did double duty so both vehicles turned onto the bitumen Bordertown/Pinnaroo road for the run up to Angas Road then to Rosy Pine Road and into camp by 5.30pm.

Unfortunately there was no provided BBQ for the workers this time, so we each set about tea along with a few rehydrating beverages of choice before solving most of the world problems prior to bed.

Sunday morning dawned overcast and quite cool with a 9.00am start down to Cox's Windmill Campsite to repair the fence posts and steel cables outlining the various camp sites taking about an hour and a half before returning to hitch-up and head for home.

A quick check of Jabuck on the way home, revealed a large former oval with ample camping areas for the Camp Cook Weekend.

# Bunkers/Flinders Ranges National Park Community Service Trip Thursday 11th - Monday 15th May

I am seeking expressions of interest to take part in a Community Service Trip that also has benefits.

Ikara-Flinders National Park has been extended by adding the Bunkers area to the park. Contained within this additional area is a former portion of the Sky Trek track operated by Willow Springs Station known as Loves Mine Track.

This track is now the access route for fire vehicles, emergency evacuations and also part of a Flinders Bike Trail (hence the emergency evacuations) and has not been maintained.

The Committee has undertaken to assist the Rangers by cutting back vegetation, filling pot holes and also filling erosion at various creek crossings along his 20km track to enable a grader to bring it to a suitable standard for  $2 \times 4$  vehicles.

The proposal is that we base ourselves at the Oraparinna Headquarters staying in the Shearers Quarters (or camping if you wish) from the 11th May through to the 14th or 15th depending on the progress of the work. Possibly arriving and setting up on the 10th so we can put in a full day's effort on the 11th.

The benefits are that you will get to see a portion of the Flinders not available to most people, the Club will build a relationship with the Ikara-Flinders and also the Gammon Ranges, Rangers that may open up other opportunities to assist.

If 40 hours of volunteer work is completed, (cumulative over the year) then you become eligible to receive a code that provides you with free entry and camping in a wide range of State National Parks. i.e. the Ngarkat working bee held recently also counts to this total, or any other volunteer work in a National Park.

- The MLR Awards Sub Committee will review the nominations and select the winner for the period.
- The winner will be announced at the annual MLR awards night.

- Always friendly and supportive consistently helping others.
- · Continued fundraising efforts.
- Volunteer efforts for the betterment of the Club.
- Behind the scenes support.

NB – there is no requirement to have lead a trip to be eligible for this award







### **Historic Car Registry**



A 90 day conditional registration scheme For Historic, Left Hand Drive and Street Rod vehicles.

Members of Mount Lofty Rangers 4WD Club are eligible for Club Registration of Historic, Left Hand Drive and Street Rod vehicles through the club.

- Inspect vehicle and make sure it meets the criteria for Club Registration.
   If previously registered bring current registration information including current permits for modified vehicles.
- Complete MR334 form and original to owner and copy retained by Mount Lofty Rangers 4WD Club
- 3. Log book supplied to vehicle owner and explanation of the use.
- 4. Record and retain a copy of MR334, Certificate of Exemption and Statutory Declaration if needed.
- Record the Log book Serial Number on the Certificate of Registration along with the date of issue, the Club Stamp and sign the certificate.
   Retain Copy of Registration papers as proof car was registered at log book issue.
